We are pleased to announce that once again the Annapolis/Anne Arundel County Chapter of the Morgan State University National Alumni Association (MSUNAA) is offering one or more scholarships to residents of Anne Arundel County. These scholarship awards are exclusively for students that are either enrolled or have applied for enrollment in Morgan State University. Scholarship amounts start at \$500.00 (Fall 2017).

In order for students to qualify for this award, the following minimum requirements must be met:

1. The applicant must have applied and been accepted to attend Morgan State University before the scholarship is awarded or the applicant must be currently enrolled in the University.
2. The applicant must work on a full-time basis toward a degree.
3. The applicant must have demonstrated qualities of positive character and leadership.
4. The applicant must be a resident of Anne Arundel County.
5. The applicant must have a Grade Point Average of 2.5 or better

To be considered for the award, the applicant must submit all required information by May 31, 2017. The primary factors to be considered in this scholarship award will be academic achievement; financial need and evidence of positive character and leadership. Applicants do not need to have a sponsor to be considered. All applicants, including the recipients of the scholarship awards will be notified by mail on or about May 31, 2017.
